Rich woodland is a low density forest with an abundance of sunlight and strong understory growth due to breaks in the tree cover. There is an abundance in wildlife and plenty of edible wild plants (Highbush Cranberry, Chokecherry, Hazelnut, Raspberry). This area is a remnant of a flood plain and is composed of mainly deciduous trees.
